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I understand I must meet all New York State legal requirements for membership on the School Board. Article 43 Section 2102 states: A member of a School Board must be able to read and write, must be a qualified voter* of the district, and have been a resident of the school district for at least one year prior to election. * “Qualified voter” must be a citizen of the U.S.; at least 18 years of age at election; at least 30 days resident.

I understand that election to the School Board makes substantial demands on a member’s time.

I also understand that I may not be an employee of the Bronxville School District and that only one member of my family may serve on the School Board at the same time.

I am aware that the NPC requires individuals seeking the NPC nomination for Trustee to be registered voters in the Bronxville, New York election district and I certify that I am registered to vote in this election district.
